
<u>ALDOT and The City of Madison</u> <u>Proposed Interchange on I-565 near Zierdt Road, Hughes</u> <u>Road Extension and I-565 Auxiliary Lanes</u> <u>City of Madison / Madison County</u>



The Alabama Department of Transportation and The City of Madison will conduct a Public Corridor Hearing for the above project as follows:

Tuesday, November 1, 2016, 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm City of Madison Municipal Complex 100 Hughes Rd Madison, AL 35758

The proposed work is adding an interchange to Interstate 565 near Zierdt Road, a Hughes Road extension and auxiliary lanes on Interstate 565 in the City of Madison in Madison County. The purpose of this meeting is to ensure that any interested parties have an opportunity to provide input regarding this project and share their views and comments regarding potential impacts. The meeting's format will have two parts. The first hour will be an informal session beginning at 5:00 pm. No formal speeches or presentations are planned. The second hour will be a Public Forum format and will begin at 6:00 pm and end at 7:00 pm. Persons wishing to make comments during the Public Forum must register at the Sign-In Table. Representatives of the City of Madison, the developer, ALDOT and consultants will be available to answer any questions relative to the project. Preliminary maps, copies of the approved Environmental Assessment and tentative schedules will be available for review.

Comments, which will become part of the official project record, may be made at any time prior to, at, or within ten days following the hearing. A court reporter will be available for anyone wishing to leave recorded comments. Written comments may be left at the hearing or mailed to:
