WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) has received funding requests for various transportation projects in Madison County through the Alabama Transportation Rehabilitation and Improvement Program (ATRIP) grant program, and ALDOT requires that ATRIP projects be added to the current TIP; and

WHEREAS, Madison County was awarded ATRIP funds for the project: Interchange at Blake Bottom Road and SR-255/Research Park Blvd, and the construction phase of the project was added to the FY 2012-2015 TIP on February 27th, 2013; and

WHEREAS, ALDOT informed the MPO and Madison County that the engineers estimate for the cost of construction for this project has increased by nearly \$5 million dollars;
