RESOLUTION NO. 13-20 HUNTSVILLE-AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AMENDING THE FUNCTIONAL CLASS OF ROADWAY NETWORK AND UPDATING THE HUNTSVILLE AREA MPO FUNCTIONALLY CLASSIFIED MAP

WHEREAS, Title 23 United States Code (USC) 134(d) and (e) establishes designation and boundary requirements for the Huntsville-Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, and 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 450.312 further provides for delineation of Transportation Management Area (TMA), Study Area, and Urbanized Area (UZA) boundaries according to US Census data; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 U.S. Census has identified new urbanized areas that lie completely within the existing Huntsville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) requires that new urbanized area and study area boundaries be updated and approved by the MPO for inclusion in a new Federal Functionally Classified Map as well as other formal planning documents; and

WHEREAS, the Huntsville-Area MPO staff, in cooperation with the Bureau of Transportation Planning of the Alabama Department of Transportation, prepared a Functional Classification Map based on the most recent FHWA changes in Roadway Classification, and Urban and TMA boundary modifications as a result of the 2010 U. S. Census, and the map was adopted by the MPO on September 12, 2012 and amended on April 23, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the FHWA and the ALDOT requires that the adopted and amended map be changed to modify the roadway classification in the Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, City of Madison has requested the following road be added to the Functional Classification Map, that designates road classification in the Huntsville Urban Area as further described below:

DUNLOP / TOWN MADISON FROM ZIERDT TO WALL TRIANA
