WHEREAS, this agreement is made and entered into by and between the State of Alabama, acting by and through the Alabama Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as State; and the Huntsville Area MPO, hereinafter referred to as MPO, and the Huntsville Public Transit, hereinafter referred to as Transit Agency; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation promulgated transportation planning regulations in 23 CFR 450.314, and

WHEREAS, the Huntsville Area MPO, the State of Alabama Department of Transportation, and the Huntsville Public Transit Agency are required by 23 CFR 450.314 to cooperatively determine their mutual responsibilities in carrying out the performance-based planning and programming requirements established by federal law, and
